Why is it still Easter? The lilies have long since faded. The roots of our tradition of fifty days of rejoicing from Easter to Pentecost lie in the the seven-day rhythm of the Jewish week, drawn from the six days of creation plus a Sabbath day. A favorite name for the Lord's Day among our ancestors in the faith was "The Eighth Day," meaning that in Christ a breakthrough to a new humanity was achieved. With that inner architecture, it mases sense to see Pentecost as a week of weeks, forty-nine days plus one, again signaling that a new age has begun in Christ and the outpouring of his Spirit.

The Jewish appreciation for Pentecost gave rise to the Jubilee year, the fiftieth year, when debts were released and prisoners set free. Today, the character of our Easter Sundays is conveyed by joyful Alleluias and the rite of sprinkling at Mass. Long ago, people expressed this joy by suspending all rules of fasting and by never kneeling at liturgy. These customs all point to our conviction that time is holy. There is an elegant balance to the Christian year: forty days of Lenten fast and discipline give way to fifty days of unrestrained rejoicing. That's why it is still Easter!

Tradiciones de Nuestra Fe

¿Por qué sigue siendo Pascua? Los lirios se han desvanecido hace mucho tiempo. Las raíces de nuestra tradición de cincuenta días de celebración desde Pascua hasta Pentecostés se encuentran en el ritmo de siete días de la semana judía, extraído de los seis días de la creación más un día de reposo. Un nombre favorito para el Día del Señor entre nuestros antepasados en la fe era "El Octavo Día", lo que significa que en Cristo se logró un gran avance hacia una nueva humanidad. Con esa arquitectura interior, tiene mucho sentido ver Pentecostés como una semana de semanas, cuarenta y nueve días más uno, señalando nuevamente que una nueva era ha comenzado en Cristo y el derramamiento de su Espíritu. El aprecio judío por Pentecostés dio origen al año jubilar, el año cincuenta, cuando las deudas fueron liberadas y los prisioneros liberados. Hoy, el carácter de nuestros domingos de Pascua es transmitido por aleluyas alegres y el rito de rociar en la Misa. Hace mucho tiempo, la gente expresó esta alegría suspendiendo todas las reglas del ayuno y nunca arrodillándose en la liturgia. Todas estas costumbres apuntan a nuestra convicción de que el tiempo es santo. Hay un equilibrio elegante en el año cristiano: Cuarenta días de ayuno y disciplina cuaresmal dan paso a cincuenta días de alegría desenfrenada. ¡Por eso sigue siendo Pascua!
